

- Pineapple means to call luck.
- Apple means peace.
- Barley means money flowing.
- Rooster means career advancement.
- Duck means surplus.
- Pig means fertility.
- Mee Sua means longevity.
- Lotus seed means having many sons.
- Cut nuts refer to silver ingots.
- Black seaweed means wealthy.
- Bamboo shoots mean wealth and happiness.
