

This program provides a collaboration opportunity for students in Asia Pacific Region to share and exchange ideas on learning to apply sustainability concepts at their Schools, focusing on the palm oil industry.

This year, ARPOS, in collaboration with RCE Penang, CGSS plans to include multi-stakeholders in the program to spread awareness about Palm Oil and Sustainability. In addition, the program and competition will be conducted online.



# PROJECT FRAMEWORK



THEMES: Social Economic Food Security Environmental This program involve two programs which are Online Program and Tik Competition. The online Tok Program involve intergenerational learning and knowledge transfer, while the Tik Tok competition focuses on empowering students' leadership in sustainability. RCE Penang & ARPOS identified the Content Experts and 6 youth volunteers from partner universities networks to educate school students on Environmental, Food Security, and Social Impact.

Then we conducted online meeting to introduce the Content Experts on Palm Oil to the youth volunteers. We organized an online program to educate and raise awareness on palm oil sustainability focuses on environmental, food security and social economic.

The recording of the program was also available on Facebook, RCE Penang at USM to continuously promoting and educating public on Palm Oil Sustainability.

To empower students to be the leaders in promoting SDGs






The project was successfully implemented on 8 October 2022. The online program started at 10.00 a.m. with welcoming remarks delivered by Professor Ir. Dr. Denny Ng Kok Sum, Chair of Academic Research on Palm Oil Sustainability (ARPOS) Network Heriot-Watt University Malaysia. Professor Ir. Dr. Denny gave a brief description of the introduction of the project. Grants from the Malaysian Palm Oil Council funded this project. This program aims to involve intergenerational learning and knowledge transfer between palm oil sustainability content experts, ARPOS, Youth, and school students via an online program focusing on the contribution of palm oil toward SDG goals. The online program was a prerequisite for the video competition, which was open to school students.



Next, the ceremony continued with our first presenter Mr. Norman Sim from Universiti Malaya-*The Relationship between Palm Oil, Sustainability and Food Security.* Mr. Norman has learned about Food Security from the content expert, Dato' Dr. Azhar Mat Esa, from the School of Industrial Technology, Universiti Sains Malaysia



After the Q&A session, the program ended on successful at 12.00 p.m.



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
This online webinar has received an overwhelming response and has reached almost 343 viewers through Webex and Facebook live on the official Facebook page of RCE Penang at USM.


