I Operation overview

\Box Description and Aim

- Project Neuru is a global ESD youth collaborative project that utilizes the "photo-voice" research method to foster ecological literacy and glocal leadership among domestic and foreign youth as a specialized project in connection with RCE Dobong-gu overseas.
- * Neuru: It is a pure Korean word for 'a long time, not rushing all at once', and it has the meaning of aiming for a long-lasting sustainable development life for youth.
- * Photo-voice: This is a field-participatory research method that promotes change in the local community by revealing one's voice and experience through photography.

□ 2023. Project Neuru Season 3 Plan

- Main topic: A House that Saves the Earth
- Period: April ~ October, 2023 / Saturday, 1~2 times a month, 09:00~10:00 (KST)
- Method: Zoom based photo-voice research
- Target: Youth from RCE cities and interested in ESD (aged 10 years over)
- Operational composition
 - Elementary school students (5 sessions + Completion ceremony)
 - Middle school (Junior high school), High school and College student (7 sessions + Completion ceremony)
- Language: English

 - · Participants can understand the house that saves the Earth through the activities each session.
 - Make a network with other participants from different countries or RCE cities and with diverse backgrounds through discussion and preparation for the presentations.

1. Points to note when filling out the activity sheet for each session

- 1) The worksheet for each session will be a data produced for submission of personal portfolios and UN University research reports, so it must be prepared and submitted faithfully.
- 2) 'City name' must be written in the city name column at the top of the worksheet.
 - ex) RCE Kitakyushu (Japan), RCE Hangzhou (China), RCE Srinagar (India), Mason city (USA),
- 3) Grade, class, and name must be written.
- 4) The worksheet must be written in Power Point, an worksheet provided by the Dobong District Office, and updated in the Padlet.
- 5) Be sure to follow the submission date of the worksheet for each session.
- 6) The writing language should be English.

2. Notes on Joining Zoom Meetings

1) Email and text messages for Zoom meeting information.

- The person in charge of Project Neuru in Dobong District Office will inform the person in charge and participants about the Zoom meeting (date, time, and Zoom address) on their personal e-mail and paddle <u>a week in advance</u>, so please guide the participants so that they can attend.
- 2) If you are unable to enter the room due to technical problems before the start of the Zoom meeting,
 - Occasionally, there may be technical problems with Zoom operation, so please guide participants so that they can log in 20 minutes before the Zoom meeting starts.
 - Dobong District Office re-sends the Zoom address to the student's personal email address.

[After Entering Zoom]

- ① After connecting to Zoom Meeting, change your name in your language into English.
 Ex) Do-bong (first name) Kim (last name)
- 2 Raise your hand when you want to ask a question while participating in the project.
- ③ When the Zoom meeting is over, be sure to participate in the attendance photo shoot.* If you are not in the photo, you are absent.
- ④ The following cases will be considered as absent from the Zoom meeting.
 - Late for more than 20 minutes to join the Zoom meeting.
 - If your face is not visible when taking a zoom photo for attendance after an activity.
