- Youth between the age group of **16-24** years can apply
- YUVA Meet is open for young professionals and undergraduate/post-graduate enrolled in a recognized educational institution or Institutes of higher learning
- Maximum **2** participants from each RCE can register for the YUVA Meet. Kindly provide the details of the applicant(s) in the prescribed **registration form** (attached). Final nominations to be done by the respective RCEs only
- Pick up and drop facility will be provided to the participants at an additional cost
- Each applicant will be required to submit the **individual application form**. The final selection of participants will be done by TERI based on your responses in the individual application form
- **Registration fee** will be charged from each participant.
  - For International participants: \$ 50

The selected participants can make the payment by cash or Demand Draft (in favor of TERI, payable at New Delhi) at the venue. ***The fee paid is non-refundable and non-transferable***

- TERI would provide lodging and boarding to all selected participants starting from 29 January 2012 (evening) – 1 February 2012 (morning). ***Participants from Delhi and NCR will not be provided with this facility***
- Outstation participants should reach Delhi by 29 January 2012. The conference will be over by 31 January 2012 (evening). Return tickets can be booked accordingly. ***The organizers will not cover the travel cost of participants***
- Participants should carry a letter of authorization from the respective RCEs
- All participants will receive participation certificate from TERI
- Selected participants will get a chance to participate in **Delhi Sustainable Development Summit (DSDS)** to be held from **2-4 February 2012**. ***If selected, the participant will be required to reschedule his/her return journey accordingly***
- **One** outstanding young participant will be felicitated with '**Green Globe Award**', an initiative by Green Globe Foundation
- Only selected participants will get an opportunity to be a part of **International Student Energy Summit**
